

IMPORTANT – SAVE FOR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL – **Wednesday**, September 6, 2017

All classroom assignments are flexible and depend on actual enrollment figures. It is possible that a few changes will be made after the first day of school if the enrollment is too high in some classrooms.

Class assignments for the 2017-18 school year will be available ON LINE starting end of August 2017. We will NOT be mailing assignments to families in August. You may access this information by going to the Skyward PaC Family Access which is an online tool for parents to view information about the students in their family.
